He focuses on familiar subjects; his room, personal objects, art materials—rendering them with muted palettes and delicate, expressive brushwork, influenced in technique and subject matter by Impressionist masters. Inspired also by music and repetition, his process involves revisiting the same subject to explore shifting emotional resonance, resulting in works that are deeply sensitive and quietly contemplative.
